Cork is Ireland's second city and capital of the ancient province of Munster. It is a small city with a population of 150,000 and a compact city centre. Yet, it has all the facilities of a modern city, as befits its status as the commercial, cultural and political capital of the South. The School have organised activity programmes for groups of teenagers for the past 30 years with great success. Our programmes are exciting and innovative. The main aim of the courses is to improve the students' use and command of the English Language through activities. Our main centres are located in good residential suburbs of Cork City (Douglas, Carrigaline & Bishopstown). All of our activities are fully supervised by professional trainers.



A - English + Activities

These courses offer a combination of language tuition in the mornings, sporting and cultural activities in the afternoons and evenings. The students are carefully graded on their arrival and levels range from beginners to advanced. These courses consist of 20 lessons of formal tuition in the mornings, afternoon programme of sports, excursions, debates, video sessions and sporting fixtures arranged against Irish teams, etc. Evening activities include discos, karaoke, bingo and video evenings.

B - English + Horse Riding

These courses offer a combination of language tuition in the mornings, sporting and cultural activities in the afternoons and evenings plus 5 hours Horse-Riding Training Weekly. These courses consist of 15 hours formal tuition in the mornings, afternoon programme of sports, excursions, debates, video sessions and sporting fixtures arranged against Irish teams, etc. Evening activities include discos, karaoke, bingo and video evenings.
